April Combined Test	Open to competitors in Beginner Novice and Novice/Training. Horse and Rider combination must compete in a minimum of 4 events, of which 3 must be full horse trials. Final year-end scores will be an average of top 4 scores achieved by the same horse and rider combination at each level. (100 pts awarded for eliminations. Withdrawal or retirement will receive a median score from their division.) Each Horse and Rider combination can only win a level award 2 consecutive years.	Yes (CT only points)
