### 2017 Show Dates

**May 2, 16 and 30**

**June 13 and 27**

**July 11 and 25**

**August 8 and 22**

2:00 pm to 8:00 pm

**Opening date – April 18**

**Tests offered:** 2015 USDF Intro Test A, B and C, 2015 USEF Training Level, First Level and Second level tests 1 thru 3, Western dressage. USEF rider tests, training, first, and second.

Event tests Beginner Novice to Prelim. Ring assignments may vary.

**Leadline:** W-W or W-T For children 8 and under and special needs of any age. Prize and pick your ribbon.

*Need to practice a special test not on this list? Call ahead and I'll clear it with the judge.*

*May need to bring your own copy of the test.*

**Entry Fees** - \$25 per test. \$20 BCHP members. Negative Coggins within 1 year required. **No cash refunds.** Notify secretary no later than 9:00 pm the Sunday prior if withdrawing to receive an entry credit - a \$5 office fee will be charged.

Schooling for non-competing horse/rider - \$25 (BCHP members free).

**Eventers Tuesday Special** – One dressage test & Cross-country schooling \$45

**On site Registration** day of show begins at 1:00 pm. Secretary's phone number (for TED only) – 267-337-4159

### **Pre-registration** (recommended).

- 1- Mail entry form with check or credit card information to secretary. Entry form with credit card information may also be emailed to Show Secretary or faxed to 610-847-5507. Entry form is on website – do not use ESDCTA form. Only 1 entry form for the whole season.
- 2- **Call or email secretary to pick a time.** Draft schedule will be posted on website. Entries are payable when time is assigned. No cash refunds, entry credit may be forwarded to future TED shows.
- 3- Check-in at secretary's stand to get a number. *EZ pass check-in (optional). At your first show buy a number for \$1. Use it every time you show at TEDS (prepayment and scheduling of test(s) is required) just wave to us in the secretary stand to let us know you are on the grounds.*

**Awards:** Six ribbons per test. Classes pinned at the end of the night. For mailed ribbon, \$3.00 prepaid fee. You may ride as many tests as you like, however, a *horse should only do each test once even with different riders. A test can be repeated HC (no ribbon) with permission.* High score amateur prize each night.

**Year-end awards** Fill out award application and read requirements. Levels offered Leadline, Intro, Starter WTC, Training – Second, eventing, western. Only the two highest-level tests per show for each horse/rider combination will count towards year-end awards.

**Attire and Equipment:** Riders must be neatly attired and horses properly presented. Shirt with sleeves required, half chaps allowed, jackets and braiding optional. ASTM/SEI Helmet required when mounted – including western.

**Other:** Readers are permitted. USEA tests run under dressage rules. Lunging non-disruptive horses is allowed in corner of schooling ring. Copies of tests will be available at show. *All shows ESDCTA registered. Let secretary know if you need scores for ESDCTA. Intro ring may have an unrated judge. Check website for updated list of judges.*
