Scott started riding in 1972 and quickly earned his way through the U.S. Pony Club ranks. He rode his first Prix St. George in 1976 and competed at Dressage at Devon. Turning professional in 1978, he operated his own stable in the Detroit area before moving South Carolina in 1983. There he operated a large stable for five years where he usually had eight horses in training and taught over 200 lessons per month.

In 1996 Scott and his family moved with horses to The Netherlands for a year to live and train with Anky VanGrunsven and Sjef Janssen on a daily basis. Prior to working with Sjef and Anky, Scott had many mentors including Robert Dover, Violet Hopkins, Hubert Rohrer, Chuck Grant, and David Lackey.

Over the years Scott has trained many riders and horses through the FEI levels. He trained a horse and rider combination to the team gold medal win at the North American Young Riders Championship in 2000, he and his wife, Katie, both earned their USDF gold medals, and they competed in numerous CDI's with many successful placing's. In 2007 he helped coach the University of South Carolina Women's Equestrian team to the National Varsity Championship.

Scott has been a USEF Dressage judge for over 30 years, he holds an "S" rating and he judges all over the country. He has judged many regional championships and judged the US Dressage Finals in Lexington Kentucky in 2017. In March of 2019 Scott and Katie bought a 17.2 hand, six year old Dutch Warmblood named Royal Jester, (Jester) and Scott rides and trains him daily.
