

Bucks County Horse Park *presents*
IN- GATE Eventing 2020

Come join us for a day of eventing fun at the Park! We will have a dressage judge in attendance, a great stadium course mixed with IN-GATE (in the ring) cross country courses. This is fashioned after the newest craze in Europe, indoor eventing. These shows feature dressage and stadium, but include a cross country course on excellent ring footing. This allows horse and rider to develop confidence over cross country fences. We are offering two cross country levels - Elementary and Beginner Novice; Novice riders are invited to try the Beginner Novice course and Starter riders can try a modified Elementary course.

Do two dressage tests, do a fix-a-test, omit dressage and do two cross country courses/stadium courses, omit all the cross country and do three stadium courses.....it's your choice to put your day together as it suits you!

No pre-entry required unless you want to reserve a specific dressage time. If a time slot is requested, we ask that you give 24-hour notice if you will not be attending so that the time slot can be freed for someone else.

Dressage – \$25 per test, \$40 per fix-a-test. Sign up for specific tests with your entry. Times will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis (unless previously arranged). Fix-a-tests must be assigned times. All Event tests will be the 2018 version.

Stadium/Cross Country – \$25 per round. The Stadium courses will be timed and set as follows:

9:00 – 10:00	Starter	2'
10:00 – 11:00	Elementary	2'3"
11:00 – 12:00	Beginner Novice	2'7"
12:00 – 12:45	Novice	2'11"

Cross Country portable fences from the Beginner Novice, Elementary, and Starter courses will be placed in the ring with heights of 2'3" and 2'7". Courses will consist of 8 to 10 fences, or do a clear round and create your own course.
