

## 2022 In-Gate Eventing

Bucks County Horse Park

What to do when the weather isn't conducive to galloping in the grass? Move the fences to the ring of course! These shows are low key and run weather permitting. We offer dressage, stadium, and a small cross country course... all in the rings to provide a safe and fun atmosphere to get off the farm and have a fun and safe outing.

Build your day to suit you! Any dressage test written for a small ring (20mx40m) is allowed, high and low XC courses between 2' and 2'6", and Stadium fences up to Novice. Do just dressage, just jumping, or any combination. Mixed levels are also acceptable.

**Fees:** \$25/dressage test, \$45/fix-a-test, \$15/jumping round (stadium or XC) Refunds for pre-entries with 24 hour notice of cancelation.

**Times: Fix-A-Tests must be pre-entered.** Dressage slots on a first-come-first-served basis from 9 am to 1 pm. Pre-entry is encouraged if you would like to ride in a specific time. Dressage schedule will be posted Thursday before the show. Stadium Courses will be set as follows. Please plan on jumping in the allotted time. XC will be set and open for rounds from 9 am to 1 pm.

9:00 – 10:00	Starter	2'
10:00 – 11:00	Elementary	2'3"
11:00 – 12:00	Beginner Novice	2'7"
12:00 – 12:45	Novice	2'11"

**Cross Country** portable fences from the Beginner Novice, Elementary, and Starter courses will be placed in the ring with heights of 2' to 2'6". Decide your course of 8 to 10 fences or do a clear round and play at will. Each rider will have 5 minutes to ride XC fences as they wish.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded to the extent possible. Riders completing a horse trial, combined test, or dressage test will be combined and placed at the conclusion of the designated stadium period.
