TESTS: All USEF 2019 Dressage Tests may be ridden, 2022 USEA Eventing Tests, 2019 USDF Introductory Level Tests, 2022 FEI Tests may be ridden, but please confirm test with secretary prior to show day, 2019 WDAA western dressage tests

FEES: \$30/class, Non-competing horses \$25. \$5 EMT fee per entry. \$15 Late Fee. Checks payable to “LVDA”. No Refunds after closing date without medical excuse.

ENTRIES: Print and mail ESDCTA form or Online via Equestrian Entries. Secretary may deny late entries submitted less than four days before show. Physical Release must be signed, Coggins (valid within 1 year of show), and full payment to LVDA must be received before riding. All riders scheduled are expected to pay fees due prior to entering another LVDA event.

DRESS: Competitors are required to abide by USEF Saddlery rules unless competing HC. Attire should be neat. Healed Boots, Sleeves, and Helmet required.

SCHEDULE: Will be posted to the LVDA website and Facebook Thursday evening before the show. Generally, the schedule will run from higher to lower levels. We will try to accommodate competitor wishes; however, this is not always possible.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded via the “Danish System” to accommodate scheduling. Over 68% Blue, Between 67.9% and 66% Red, Between 65.9% and 63% Yellow, Between 62.9% and 60% White, Between 59.9% and 57% Pink, Between 56.9% and 55% Green.

LVDA YEAR END AWARDS: Awards at each level plus additional awards. Must be member at time score is earned. Five scores required, three must be from LVDA events. Volunteer Hours required. See the LVDA website for details.
